## Introduction

Tax audit is an essential element of self-assessment system. During the audit process, which is carried out with the objective of increasing the rate of voluntary compliance, the Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (IRBM) applies numerous techniques and tools to examine the taxpayers' records, financial affairs, documentations, substance of documentations and business practices. The IRBM has expressed in its recent tax audit framework that it expects the tax agents representing the taxpayers to be professional, honest, cooperative and highly knowledgeable on the law as well as practices in order to handle the tax audit process effectively and efficiently. It is also to the interest of the taxpayers that the audit is completed cooperatively and efficiently.
