

STAMP DUTY LEGISLATION UPDATES

Introduction

The Institute is pleased to present an intensive one-day workshop on updates to the Stamp Duty Legislation. This workshop will be presented by a retired tax officer who was fully involved in the development of the Stamp Duty (Amendment) Bill 2016. Participants will benefit from having a broad understanding of the various changes to the Stamp Duty regime and how to apply what they have learnt to their own business affairs or other related activities.

New provisions were introduced to address compliance issues such as filing of return, duty to keep records, appointment of agent, etc. There are also changes in Section 15 and 15A in respect of reliefs in the case of reconstruction and amalgamation of companies and transfer of property between associated companies respectively. One of the significant changes that will impact the public, including individuals is in Section 21 (Certain contracts to be chargeable as conveyances on sale). The section has been amended to charge ad valorem duty on any agreement for the conveyance on sale of any property.
