Between June and December 2017 and up to 2 May 2018, the Director General of Inland Revenue (DGIR) has issued 14 Public Rulings (PR) in total which imposes many compliance requirements on various classes of taxpayers.

Non-compliance to these Public Rulings and other regulations issued by the DGIR will create risks to taxpayers with the high possibility of tax audit adjustments being made by the DGIR.
