INTRODUCTION

Returns Forms are the best tools for the Inland Revenue Board to determine whether income and expenses and in fact a person's income-earning activities, have been correctly stated. This is possible from the relationship between various items in the return forms which may hide links not readily visible to the taxpayer. The emphasis of this seminar would be what on the details required in the return forms actually reflect and how Revenue may utilise them for enforcement purposes.
