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2) Revised Guidelines for Principal Hub Incentive

The MIDA has issued the revised [Guidelines for Principal Hub Incentive dated 7 July 2017](#), which replaces the [Guidelines dated 6 April 2015](#) (as reported in our [e-CTIM TECH-DT 40/2015](#)).

The revision includes an elaboration on the principal hub (PH) incentives and PH conditions for new companies and existing companies, and amendments to the eligibility criteria and mechanism sections of the Guidelines.

3) One-Stop Centre for Incentives Information Offered by The Federal Government (i-Incentives)

i-Incentives is a portal that provides information on incentives offered by the Malaysian Federal Government.

The Incentive Coordination and Collaboration Office (ICCO) has been established by MIDA with the aim of improving the central coordination of all incentive offerings. This initiative is to enhance the effectiveness of the government's incentive mechanism by increasing

transparency, eliminating duplication and linking to performance. The list of incentives offered by all Ministries and agencies will be updated from time to time.
