### RMCD – Announcements on Tourism Tax

The Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) has made the following announcements on Tourism Tax:

a. Announcement 1-2017 and 2-2017

The RMCD has withdrawn the General Guide on Tourism Tax (revised as at 16 August 2017) and replaced it with the <u>General Guide on Tourism Tax (revised as at 29 August 2017)</u> to clarify issues relating registration, charging and collection of tourism tax, transitional period and a broad listing of frequently asked questions (FAQs) to assist the operators.

The <u>Newsletter Tourism Tax No.1/2017</u> (FAQs) is no longer applicable and is replaced by the <u>General Guide on Tourism Tax (revised as at 29 August 2017)</u>.

The <u>General Guide on Tourism Tax (revised as at 29 August 2017)</u> has subsequently been withdrawn and replaced with the <u>General Guide on Tourism Tax (revised as at 31 August 2017)</u> which has subsequently been withdrawn and replaced with the <u>General Guide on Tourism Tax (revised as at 26 September 2017)</u>. A list of amendments can be found on page 43 of the <u>General Guide on Tourism Tax (revised as at 26 September 2017)</u>.

(Note: The General Guide on Tourism Tax and the Newsletter Tourism Tax No. 1/2017 were previously reported in our <u>e-CTIM TECH-IT 28/2017</u> dated 18 August 2017).

#### b. Announcement 3-2017

Travel and tour agencies which have tour package contracts made before **1 September 2017** with various accommodation premise operators to provide accommodation rooms to foreign tourists from 1 September 2017 until 31 March 2018 may make an application to the Ministry of Tourism and Culture to obtain a supporting letter to seek an exemption from charging and collecting Tourism Tax from the Minister of Finance under subsection 9(2) of the <u>Tourism Tax Act 2017</u>.
