Minutes of Customs-Private Sector Consultative Panel (CPSCP) Meeting No. 1/2017

The Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) has released the minutes of the [Customs-Private Sector Consultative Panel \(CPSCP\) Meeting No. 1-2017](#) held on 5 May 2017. The issues raised at the meeting include the following:

- Self-Certification Regime – Proposal to impose stricter penalties against fraudulent declarations.
- New Customs Agent Compliance Policy and Demerit Point System for Customs Agent.
- Standard Operating Procedure on the Demerit System.
- Single Agent Code.
- Different Customs Procedures adopted by Free Zones in different states.
- Compounds for minor errors.
- Reintroduction of Security Ink.
- 100 percent scanning and congestion at Penang Port.
- Customs inspection related services by third party service providers in Pasir Gudang and Port Klang.
- Customs Working Days and Hours.
- Amendments to Customs Form K1/K2.
- Acceptance of amendments on Customs K1 Form for GST purposes.
- Breakdown of *Sistem Maklumat Kastam (SMK)*.
- Direct Trader Payment Scheme.
- Manifest (K4) declaration showing Consignee “To Order”.
- Direct carrier to hold back delivery order pending consignees.
- Shipment detained by Customs preventive.
- GST implication arising from salary deduction from foreign workers, specifically for accommodation costs and immigration levy under minimum wage policy.
- Other matters.
