Update on Goods and Services Tax (GST) Guide on Tax Invoice and Records Keeping

The Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) has updated the <u>GST Guide on Tax Invoice</u> <u>and Records Keeping – revised as at 5 December 2016</u>. The following is added to the earlier version (updated 30 June 2016).

	questions	Q21. I issue a credit note for foreign denominated tax invoices, should I use the prevailing exchange rate or the historical exchange rate?	
		A21. You need to use the historical exchange rate which is the rate stated in the related tax invoice. You are required to use this type of exchange rate consistently.
