RMCD – Registration for Service Tax on Digital Service on the MySST website

The Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) has uploaded an announcement on the [Registration for Service Tax on Digital Service](#) implementation on the [MySST website](#) on 30 September 2019.

According to the announcement on the [MySST website](#), foreign service provider who provides digital service to consumer in Malaysia and who is liable to be registered under Part IXA of Service Tax Act 2018 [refer to [Service Tax \(Amendment\) Act 2019 \[Act A1597\]](#) as Foreign Registered Person can start applying for registration with effect from **1 October 2019**.
