- Article 56: No member shall be entitled to vote on any question either personally or by proxy at any General Meeting of the Institute or at a poll whose subscription is overdue for three (3) months. [Note: Six (6) months for 28th AGM due to COVID-19 pandemic]
- Article 40: Any Member entitled to be present and vote at a meeting may submit any motion to any General Meeting, provided that in the case of an ordinary resolution, he shall serve upon the Institute at least ten (10) clear days before the day appointed for the meeting, a notice in writing by him containing the proposed ordinary resolution, and stating his intention to submit the same.
