# RMCD'S RESPONSE TO CTIM OPERATIONAL INDIRECT TAX ISSUES DUE TO COVID-19 OUTBREAK AND ECONOMY SLOWDOWN

The Institute has received a <u>response</u> from the Royal Malaysian Customs Department ("RMCD") on 10 June 2020 to the <u>CTIM Operational Indirect Tax Issues due to COVID-19 Outbreak and Economy Slowdown which was submitted on 22 April 2020. The following operational indirect tax issues were raised in the CTIM paper: -</u>

- 1. Extension of Time for Submission of Returns and Payment of Tax due to the extended Movement Control Order ("MCO") period
- 2. Extension of Deadline for Submission of Service Tax on Digital Services ("SToDS") Return and Payment of Tax
- 3. GST Refund Bank Guarantee ("BG")
- 4. Import duty drawback for traders
- 5. Waiver of penalties
- 6. Expedite customs clearance procedures at customs port to allow essential goods to be imported quickly
  - LMW status companies with monthly LMW reporting (i.e. M1 and M2)
- 7. Notice on "Permohonan Semakan Semula (Review)" issued by the RMCD dated 27 March 2020
- 8. Background [Licensed Manufacturing Warehouse ("LMW")]
- 9. More than one company operating LMW from the same location or premises
- 10. Postpone the issuance of Bill of Demand ("BOD") during the MCO period
- 11. Standardize / Digitalise applications to Tax Authorities
