396/2019 Customs Duties (Exemption) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 2019 Gazette date: 31 December 2019	This Order came into operation on 1 January 2020. It amends the Customs Duties (Exemption) Order 2017 [P.U.(A) 445/2017] (reported in our e-CTIM TECH-IT 6/2018 dated 18 January 2018) in item 67, Part I of the Schedule on the persons exempted as follows:- • in paragraph (viii) by substituting for the words "Murphy Sarawak Oil Co. Ltd" the words "PTTEP Sarawak Oil Limited" (new name); and • in paragraph (ix) by substituting for the words "Murphy Sabah Oil Co. Ltd" the words "PTTEP Sabah Oil Limited" (new name).
