## Submission of Income Tax Return Forms (ITRF) and Payment of Tax Through Electronic Means

Further to our <u>e-CTIM No.33/2012</u> informing you of the availability of the mobile filing facility for resident individuals with no business income, the Chief Executive Officer of the Inland Revenue Board (IRB), YBhg. Dato' Dr. Mohd Shukor B. Hj. Mahfar has written to the professional bodies on 12 April 2012 listing the electronic facilities available to taxpayers/tax agents for transactions with the IRB. In calendar year 2012, submission of ITRF via e-filing will be granted a 15-day grace period from the due date of filing.

The Inland Revenue Board (IRB) has informed that the Income Tax Return (Form BE) of a resident individual who does not carry on a business can now be submitted through m-filing.

Payment of the balance of tax payable may be done through the e-Payment facility.
