## INITIATIVES DONE BY FGPT SINCE 2007

#### 2011

 Phase II of MyCoID Gateway System (MGS) integrating the systems of five participating agencies; IRB, EPF, HRDF, SOCSO & SME Corp.

#### 2012

- Maintained past amendments made to the Public Rulings
- Implement the waiver of form for tax incentives
- Reduced the time bar for assessment of Income Tax Act; (6 to 5 years)

#### 2013

- Improvement on payment of sales tax and tax returns by RMC
- Continue improvement the income tax system on a single source of employment income not to file tax and enforcing compensation for late refund of taxes


#### 2014


