REMINDER TO DECLARE THE RIGHT AND CORRECT AMOUNT OF INCOME TAX

The Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (IRBM) would like to inform that the submission of the Income Tax Return Form for Year of Assessment 2013 (ITRF 2013) through e-Filing can be done effective March 1, 2014.

Taxpayers will be able to use the service by going to the e-Filing website at https://e.hasil.gov.my or to the IRBM's Official Portal at www.hasil.gov.my.

To avoid any online congestion, we urge taxpayers to submit their ITRF 2013 as early as possible and not wait until the last minute. Upon self-assessment and submission of the ITRF, the balance of tax payable must be paid to the IRBM by the due date for the submission of the tax return to avoid any late payment penalty being imposed.

The deadlines for submission of ITRF 2013 and payment of balance of tax payable for each category of forms are as follows:

IRBM would also like to remind every taxpayer to fill in accurate information and declare their income tax correctly. All supporting documents relating to the tax reliefs and expenses claimed in computing the income tax should be retained for seven years for tax audit purposes.

IRBM will conduct enforcement actions such as audits and investigations

in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act 1967. Action will

be taken if the IRBM finds there is any doubt over the information and

the amount of income declared by the tax payer.

For taxpayers (Individuals or Companies) who have overpaid tax,

IRBM would like to advise them to ensure that the Bank Account

information is completely and accurately filled in the ITRF, so that

processing of refunds of overpaid tax can be done promptly and

efficiently.
