#### Income tax

### 1. Income Tax (Exemption)(No.5)(Revocation) Order 2010 [P.U.(A) 72/2010]

The above Order, gazetted on 11 March 2010 and effective from the year of assessment 2004, revokes the Income Tax (Exemption) (No. 5) Order 1989 [P.U.(A) 295/1989]. The 1989 Order stipulates that 70% of the income remitted from a construction project (outside Malaysia) which commenced after 21 October 1988 by a Malaysian resident company is exempt from Malaysian income tax. The revocation of the 1989 Order is necessary due to the amendment to Paragraph 28, Schedule 6 of the Income Tax Act 1967 (as introduced by the Finance Act 2003) to exempt the income of any person, other than a resident company carrying on the business of banking, insurance or sea or air transport, derived from sources outside Malaysia and received in Malaysia with effect from the year of assessment 2004.

#### 2. Double taxation agreement with Government of Brunei [P.U.(A) 78/2010]

The double taxation agreement (DTA) signed by Malaysia with the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam has been gazetted but has not entered into force. It shall have effect:

- in respect of taxes withheld at source, to income derived on or after the first day of January in the calendar year following the year in which the DTA enters into force;
   and
- (b) in respect of other taxes on income, to income chargeable for any year of assessment beginning on or after the first day of January of the second calendar year following the year in which the DTA enters into force and subsequent years of assessment.

## 1. Grace period for submission of Form E

The Institute has just received a letter dated 31 March 2010 from the Inland Revenue Board (IRB) confirming that a grace period of 7 days is granted for filing of Employer Return Form E 2009, i.e. until 7 April 2010. This grace period is applicable to filing by post and by hand but is not applicable to e-filing. Taxpayers can submit the Form E 2009 at the Processing Centre in Pandan Indah and at the IRB branches. Tax agents are not allowed to submit the Form E 2009 at the IRB branches.

#### 2. Additional information on filing programme for year 2010

The IRB has issued a circular which provides additional information on the filing programme for year 2010. Based on the circular, a grace period of 7 days is allowed for paper filing of Return Forms BE, B, M, P, TP, TJ and TF by hand and by post. This grace period is also applicable to payment of tax under Section 103(1) of the Income Tax Act 1967. The grace period does not apply to e-filing of these returns.

## 3. Mandatory application and renewal of tax agent licence.

The Ministry of Finance (MOF) has issued a letter dated 26 March 2010 informing that with effect from 1 July 2010, applications and renewals of tax agent licence are required to be made online through Sistem Maklumat Pengurusan Cukai (SMPC). Members are reminded to renew their licences 4 months before the expiry date.

## 1. Revised 2010 Tax Returns Filing Programme

The Inland Revenue Board (IRB) has issued the revised 2010 Tax Return Filing Programme on 2 April 2010. The revised programme is the result of the recent dialogues between the professional bodies and the IRB. Some of the important changes are as follows:

- i) A grace period of 7 days after the due date for filing of the 2009 tax return forms BE, B, M, P, TP, TJ and TF is allowed for submissions by post and by hand. The grace period is also applicable to the payment of outstanding taxes under subsection 103(1), Income Tax Act 1967.
- ii) The 7-days grace period is also allowed for submission of tax return forms C, R, C1, TA, TC and TR, by post and by hand where the due date for filing of the tax returns falls in the calendar year 2010. The grace period is also applicable to the payment of outstanding taxes under subsection 103(1), Income Tax Act 1967.
  - **Exception:** For companies which closed their accounts to 30 June 2009, although the due date for filing of their tax returns is on 31January 2010, the grace period of 14 days previously granted (to 14 February 2010) continues to apply.
- iii) Applications for an extension of time to file tax returns may be made provided the applications are received at least 15 days before the due date for submission, and not "within 15 days before the due date of filing" as stated in the Institute's circular, e-CTIM No. 8/2010. Applications for an extension of time to pay the outstanding taxes are to be made together with the applications for an extension of time to file the tax returns. The applications should be supported by strong reasons and will be considered based on the merits of each case.

### 2. New Tax Agent Approval Number

Please be informed that the format of new tax agent licence number has been changed to xx/xxxx/xx/xxxx (i.e. 12 digits.). For Tax Return Forms C, TA, TC and TR, the relevant boxes for tax agent approval number has 13-digit space. However, in the Tax Return Forms B, BE, M, P, TF, TJ and TP only provide a 10-digit spacing for the tax agent to fill in.

The Institute has sought clarification from the IRB on the issue and was advised as follows: For Form BE & B 2009 --- Write the additional 2 digits below the box provided and ensure that it does not go beyond the border indicated by the adjustment mark.

For Forms C1, M, P, TP, TJ and TF 2009 --- Write the additional 2 digits to the right of the box provided.

### **PUBLIC PRACTICE**

## 1. Income Tax (Industrial Building Allowance)(Building under Privatisation Project and Private Financing Initiatives) Rules 2010 [P.U.(A) 119/2010]

The Rules stipulate that a building constructed under a privatisation project and private financing initiatives by the Privatization/PFI Committee, Public Private Partnership Unit, Prime Minister's Department; and pursuant to an agreement entered into between a person and the Government of Malaysia or statutory body on a build-lease-maintain-transfer basis (BLMT Agreement) and for which no consideration has been paid by the Government of Malaysia or statutory body to that person, shall be treated as an industrial building with effect from the year of assessment 2009.

The initial allowance and annual allowance of the industrial building shall be 10% and 6% respectively. The balance of residual expenditure shall be reduced by the amount of any compensation received by such person; and the disposal value of the asset shall be taken to be zero when the BLMT agreement expires.

## 2. Income tax relief on interest from housing loan

The Inland Revenue Board (IRB) issued a media release on the matter on 9 April 2010. It essentially states the conditions under which a relief may be claimed in respect of interest on housing loans taken by an individual
