**[CUSTOMS \(PROHIBITION OF EXPORTS\) \(AMENDMENT\) \(NO.2\) ORDER 2016 \[P.U. \(A\) 218/2016\]](#)**

The above [Order](#) was gazetted on 1 August 2016 and comes into operation on 1 September 2016. It amends the Second Schedule to the [Customs \(Prohibition of Exports\) Order 2012 \[P.U. \(A\) 491/2012\]](#) i.e. list of goods which may not be exported except under an export licence. The amendments replace the Ministry of International Trade and Industry as the licence issuing Ministry of cement clinker (item 12, subheading 2523 10 000) and Portland cement (item 13, subheading 2523.29 900) with the Ministry of Domestic Trade, Co-operatives and Consumerism. The Order also removes the following goods from the Second Schedule:
